ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS – SOUTH BANK SPINE ROUTE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to install waiting and loading restrictions, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Upper Ground which lies between the junctions of Duchy Street and Broadwall and the coaches only bays on the up ramp between Upper Ground and Waterloo Road.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available:-

(1) For the up ramp via (a) north-east bound via Belvedere Road/Upper Ground, Cornwall Road, Stamford Street (A3200) and Waterloo Road, and (b) south-west bound via Belvedere Road, Concert Hall Approach, and Waterloo Road.

(2) For Upper Ground via (a) north-east bound, Cornwall Road, Stamford Street (A3200), Hatfields, Upper Ground, and (b) south-west bound via Broadwall, Stamford Street (A3200), Waterloo Road, the unnamed down ramp between Waterloo Road and Belvedere Road, Belvedere Road/Upper Ground.

3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order comes into force on 23rd October 2023 and will continue for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works will take place between 23rd October 2023 and 5th November 2023, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 1 month.
