Water maintenance works, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of St Julian's Farm Road which lies between its

junction with Knight's Hill and the western property boundary of No. 88 Knight's Hill. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via a) Knight's Hill, Norwood Road, York Hill, Royal Circus, Pyrmont Grove, Canterbury Grove, Thurlestone Road,

Dodbrooke Road, Hainthorpe Road, Wolfington Road and Casewick Road, and (b) Casewick Road, Thornlaw Road and Knight's Hill. 3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent

as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs. The Order will come into force on 16th October 2023 and continue in force for a maximum duration of 3 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been

completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works will take place between 16th October 2023 and 29th October 2023, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 3 months.
