- Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer. The order comes into force on the 21st October 2023 to remain in force for up to 2 months. (Note: Works are planned to take place between
- 21st and 29th October).
- The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway. Dated 6th October 2023.
