## Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 The Lewisham (St Asaph Road, SE4) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No.2) Order 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made the above named temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM

- 1. (1) Road closure in St Asaph Road, SE4 between Avignon Road and Dundalk Road. (2) The diversion routes for traffic affected by the prohibition are via (i) Avignon Road and Dundalk Road, and vice versa; and (ii) Avignon Road, Drakefell Road, Endwell Road, Mantile Road, and St
- prohibition are via (i) Avignon Road and Dundalk Road, and vice versa; and (ii) Avignon Road, Drakefell Road, Endwell Road, Mantle Road, and St Asaph Road.

  2. No parking/waiting in St Asaph Road, between Avignon Road and Dundalk Road

Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes and

- anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.

  4. The order comes into force on the 21st October 2023 to remain in force for up to 2 months. (Note: Works are expected to be carried out between 23rd and 27th October 2023).

  5. The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the
- highway.
