ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A102 GLA ROAD (BLACKWALL TUNNEL SOUTHERN APPROACH, ROYAL BOROUGH OF GREENWICH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2023

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable structural inspection works to take place on the A102 south-eastbound on-slip road between its junctions with Blackwall Lane and Blackwall Tunnel Southern Approach.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering or proceeding on the A102 south-eastbound on-slip road between its junctions with Blackwall Lane and Blackwall Tunnel Southern Approach. The Order will be effective at certain times between 23rd October 2023 and 23rd April 2024, every night 10:00 PM until 5:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via Blackwall Lane southbound, Woolwich Road, Horn Lane and the A102 south-eastbound on-slip road to normal route of travel.
