ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A200 GLA ROAD (DRUID STREET, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2023

- 1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under sections 14(1), (5), (7) and 15(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and is satisfied that these works will last in excess of 18 months for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable building construction works to take place on Druid Street in the London Borough of Southwark.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle except authorised goods vehicles from stopping on Druid Street north-eastern side from a point 33.8 metres northwest of the north-western kerb line of Coxson Way to a point 82 metres north-westwards.
 For the purposes of this Order authorised goods vehicles are those being use in to carry materials being used in connection with the redevelopment of Chapter Living or any other development in the London area authorised by Transport for London to use this facility.
 The Order will be effective at certain times from 12:01 AM on the 28th October 2023 until the works have been completed. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:

to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
- (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. The Order will be revoked upon completion of these works.
