ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A5 GLA ROAD (EDGWARE ROAD, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) (No.5) ORDER 2023

- 1. Transport for London in consultation with the City of Westminster hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable water mains refurbishment works to take place on the A5 Edgware Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from exiting Church Street north-eastern arm at its junction with Edgware Road. The Order will also permit two-way operation on Church Street

between its junctions with Edgware Road and Penfold Street. The Order will be effective at certain times between 3rd November 2023 and 3rd December 2023, every Friday 9:30 AM until Sunday 5:00 PM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner.

- The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs. 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes; (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police
 - constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Penfold Street and Broadley Street to normal route of travel.
