ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A23 GLA ROAD (PURLEY WAY, LONDON BOROUGH OF CROYDON) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2023

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the abovenamed Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
 The purpose of the Order is to enable water mains maintenance works.
- The purpose of the Order is to enable water mains maintenance works to take place on the A23 Purley Way.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 (I) turning right from the A23 Purley Way onto Waddon Way;
 - (2) proceeding straight ahead from Imperial Way into Waddon Way at its junction with the A23 Purley Way.
 - The Order will be effective at certain times from 7:00 AM on 20th October 2023 until 7:00 PM on 23rd October 2023 or when the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to
- time be indicated by traffic signs.

 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.

5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via Purley Way Northbound, Denning Avenue,

Warham Road, Hailing Park Road, Waddon Way to normal route of travel.
