ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A23 GLA ROAD (STREATHAM HILL, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2023

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable trial hole and survey works to take place on the A23 Streatham Hill.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from stopping on Streatham Hill between its junctions with Sternhold Avenue and the A205 Streatham Place/Christchurch Road. The Order will also permit all vehicles to use the northbound and

southbound bus lanes on Streatham Hill between its junctions with Sternhold Avenue and the A205 Streatham Place/ Christchurch Road. Works will be phased such that some restrictions will apply only at certain times. The Order will be effective at certain times between 29th October 2023 and 5th May 2024, every night 9:00 PM until 5:00 AM or when the

works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions

- will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs. 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire
 - brigade, ambulance or police purposes; (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for
 - London.
