ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS – ABBEVILLE ROAD, HOLWOOD PLACE AND ST. ALPHONSUS ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to facilitate the installation of new HV cables, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth after consulting Transport for London (TfL) have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering the lengths of Abbeville Road from the western kerb-line of Park Hill south-westward for 20 metres; Holwood Place between the junctions of Clapham Park Road and Teignmouth Close; St. Alphonsus Road from the south-west kerb-line of Clapham Park Road south-westward for 30 metres. The Order also bans traffic from turning left from Park Hill into Abbeville Road and suspends the south-east and easterly bus lane on Clapham Park Road.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available for:- (a) Abbeville Road via Clapham Park Road, (A3) Clapham Common South Side, (A24) Clapham Common South Side and Elms Road and vice versa; (b) Holwood Place via Clapham Park Road and St. Alphonsus Road and vice versa; (c) St. Alphonsus Road via Clapham Park Road, Abbeville Road and St. Alphonsus and vice versa.

3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order comes into force on 18 November 2023 and continues for a 6-month maximum duration (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works will take place for Abbeville Road between 18-26 November 2023, Holwood Place between 11-15 December 2023, and St. Alphonsus Road between 6-14 January 2024, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 6 months.
