BELVEDERE ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable works involving the operation of a crane to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, after

consulting Transport for London (TfL), intend to make an

- Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban:(a) vehicles (including cyclists) from entering that
  length of Belvedere Road which lies between
  Concert Hall Approach and a point 99 metres
  - Concert Hall Approach and a point 99 metres south-west of Concert Hall Approach;

    (b) pedestrians from using that length of the south-
- eastern footway of Belvedere Road which lies between Concert Hall Approach and a point 99 metres south-west of Concert Hall Approach (an alternative route for pedestrians would be available on the north-western footway of Belvedere Road).

2 Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be

- available via (a) Concert Hall Approach, Waterloo Road roundabout, York Road, and Chicheley Street; and (b) Chicheley Street, York Road, Waterloo Road roundabout, and the slip road (the down ramp) linking Waterloo Road and Belvedere Road.

  3. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

  4. The Order would come into force on 24 November 2023
- 4. The Order would come into force on 24 November 2023 and would continue for a 6-month maximum duration (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would take place between 24 November 2023 and 26 November 2023, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the
