

## LICENSING ACT 2003

### Application for Variation of Premises Licence

Charlie Boxer has applied to the London Borough of Lambeth to vary a Premises Licence, in respect of the following premises: Italo Delicatessen, 13 Bonnington Square, London SW8 1TE.

The nature of the variation is as follows: To vary the nature of our alcohol licence, to allow for us to sell alcohol inside the premises from 8.30 pm - 11 pm, and to maintain our current licence, which allows us to sell Alcohol from 9.30 am - 8.30 pm, both on and off the premises. This is for Monday - Sunday.

A responsible authority or any other person may make representation to the licensing authority in respect of this application. Representations must be made in writing, either by post to the above address, or by email to [licensing@lambeth.gov.uk](mailto:licensing@lambeth.gov.uk) and must be received no later than 17th December, 2023

It is an offence to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with a licensing application, and the maximum fine for which a person is liable on summary conviction for that offence shall not exceed level 5 on the standard scale (£5,000).
