

Public consultation on the draft revised Local Information Requirement (the Local List)

Lambeth Council is undertaking public consultation on the draft revised list of Local Information Requirements, also known as the Local List. This document is available on the Council's dedicated consultation webpage at: <https://beta.lambeth.gov.uk/consultations>

The Local List sets out various types of plans, drawings and supporting documents and indicates which of these will be required in connection with different types of applications submitted to the local planning authority (LPA) for determination.

The current list of local information requirements was adopted in July 2016 and is available on the Council's website. Officers have reviewed the adopted Local List in the light of current national, London-wide and Borough level planning policies and propose several revisions to it. The feedback from the public consultation exercise will be reviewed by officers and used to inform any amendments to the draft revised Local List. Once adopted, the revised Local List will replace the current list of local information requirements.

The revised Local List will enable relevant applications to be accompanied by appropriately detailed information, thereby minimising the risk of delay in validating applications and in consulting on, assessing and determining applications.

The consultation on the draft revised Local List will take place over a period of 8 weeks, starting on 30 October 2023 and finishing on 24 December 2023.
