ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – NEWPORT STREET

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable detailed bridge examination works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, after consulting Transport for London (TfL), intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Newport Street, which lies between the junctions of Whitgift Street and Old Paradise Street for a length of approximately 150 metres.

2. An alternative route for affected vehicles would be available via Old Paradise Street, Lambeth Walk, Fitzalan Street, Kennington Road, Black Prince Road and vice versa.

3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing and covering of the appropriate traffic signs. Access for residents would be maintained.

4. The Order would come into force on 27 November 2023 at 22:00 hrs and would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the works would take place between 27 November 2023 at 22:00 hrs and 28th November 2023 at 06:00 hrs, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the Order would also have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 1 month.
