## LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 The Lewisham (Cranfield Road, SE4) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made the above named temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

 (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in Cranfield Road, SE4.
(2) The diversion route for traffic affected by the prohibitions is via Breakspears Road, Harefield Road and Wickham Road, and vice versa.

 No parking/waiting in (i) Breakspears Road, between the projected common boundaries of Nos. 49/51 and Nos. 69/71 Breakspears Road; and (ii) Wickham Road, between the projected northern boundary of St Peters Church and the projected common boundary of Nos. 47/49 Wickham Road

 Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.

 The Order comes into force on the 2nd January 2024 to remain in force for up to 6 months. (Note: Works are planned to be carried out between 2nd January and 16th April 2024).

5. The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
