NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council intend to make this temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of telecommunication works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order will be as indicated below. 1. (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in (i) King Alfred Avenue between Southend Lane and a point 10 metres northwards, and (ii) Sedgehill Road, the western section fronting Nos. 215 to 225 between Southend Lane and the main north/south section of Sedgehill Road. (2) The alternative routes for traffic affected by the closures shall be via local neighbouring roads.

2. No parking/waiting in Southend Lane, both sides, between Cowdrey Mews and Nos. 196/198 Southend Lane.

 Exemption will be provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.

 The order is intended to come into force on the 16th January 2024 to remain in force for up to 2 months. (Note: Works are planned to be completed in one day on 16th January 2024).

5. The prohibitions will apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
