## Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 The Lewisham (Stanstead Road, SE23) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made the above named temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM

- 1. (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in Stanstead Road between Waldram Crescent and the projected common boundary of 15 & 17 Stanstead Road. (2) The diversion routes for traffic affected by the prohibitions are via (i) Waldram Crescent, Waldram Place, Perry Vale, Waldram Park Road, Sunderland Road, and Stanstead Road; and (ii) Waldram Park Road, Sunderland Road, and Stanstead Road.
- Suspension of the one way working in Stanstead Road between Waldram Crescent and Roiack Road.
- 3. Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.
- 4. The Order comes into force on the 8th January 2024 to remain in force for up to 2 months. (Note: Works are planned to be carried out between 8th and 12th January 2024).
- 5. The prohibitions and suspensions apply as, when and to the extent
