## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A23 GLA ROAD (BRIXTON HILL, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2023

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.

- (I) permit all vehicles to use the northbound and southbound bus lanes on Brixton Hill between its junctions with Fairmount Road and

  (2) prohibit pedal cycles entering or exiting Josephine Avenue at its junction with Brixton Hill

  Works will be phased such that some restrictions will apply only at
- The Order will be effective from 7:00 AM on 13th November 2023 until 7:00 PM on 17th February 2024 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
    (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police
  - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
