ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A2 GLA ROAD (LEWISHAM WAY, LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2023

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable telecommunication cable installation works to take place on the A2 Lewisham Way.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) stopping on Lewisham Way between its junctions with Lucas Street and Tanner's Hill;
 - (2) stopping in the Parking bay on Tanner's Hill outside No.171 Lewisham Way.

Works will be phased such that some restrictions will apply only at certain times.

The Order will be effective at certain times between 13th November 2023 and 18th November 2023, every night 10:00 PM until 5:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
