## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE A23 GLA ROAD (PURLEY WAY, LONDON BOROUGH OF CROYDON) (TEMPORARY BANNED TURN) ORDER 2023

- I. Transport for London in consultation with the London Borough of Croydon hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable gully replacement works to take place on the A23, Purley Way.
- The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from turning right from the northbound carriageway of the A23 Purley Way into Trafalgar Way.
  - The Order will be effective between 26th November 2023 and 31st January 2024 each night from 9:00 PM to 5:00 AM or when the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
  - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs;

For vehicles travelling northbound on Purley Way wanting to turn right into Trafalgar Way via continuing northbound on Purley Way, Ampere Way, Ampere Roundabound, back on to Ampere Way, southbound Purley Way and return to normal route of travel.
