

Licensing Act 2003: Full Variation of a Premises Licence

Notice is hereby given that ATLANTICO (UK) LTD has applied to the City of Westminster on **15/12/2023** to vary the premises licence for **DELICIAS DE PORTUGAL, 58-60 Lupus Street, London, SW1V 3EE.**

The proposed variation is to: Add the Sale of Alcohol ON License to our existent Sale of Alcohol Off License - Monday to Saturday from 10:00 Am Until 20:00 and Sunday's from 10:00 Am until 18:00; To update the plan of the premises to include the seating area (as a Licensable area - ON and OFF License), no other changes on the plan of the premises Also, to remove Condition 10 of the actual Premises License "There shall be no consumption of alcohol by customers at the tables and chairs outside the premises. And remove Condition 17 "No single cans or bottles of beer or cider or spirit mixtures shall be sold at the Premises".

Any person who wishes to make a representation in relation to this application must give notice in writing of his/her representation by **12/01/2024** stating the grounds for making said representation to: **Licensing Service, Westminster City Hall, 64 Victoria Street, London SW1E 5QP.**

The Licensing Authority must receive representations by the date given above. The Licensing Authority will have regard to any such representation in considering the application. It is an offence, under section 158 of the Licensing Act 2003, to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in or in connection with an application for premises licence and the maximum fine on being convicted of such an offence is £5000.
