ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – GUERNSEY GROVE AND HAWARDEN GROVE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable pedestrian improvement works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that section of;

- (a) Guernsey Grove, which lies between the north-eastern kerb-line of Rosendale Road and a point 15 metres north-east of that kerb-line; and
- (b) Hawarden Grove, which lies between the north-eastern kerb-line of Rosendale Road and a point 15 metres north-east of that kerb-line.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be provided via;

- (a) Rosendale Road, Hawarden Grove and Croxted Road; and
- (b) Rosendale Road, Guernsey Grove, Croxted Road.

3. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 8th January 2024 and would continue for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the works would take place between the 8th January 2024 and the 4th March 2024, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the Order would also have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 2 months.
