The general effect of the Orders is to remove a length of loading place on the north-east side of Mepham Street by 3 metres and extend the (double yellow lines "at any time" waiting restrictions adjacent to the loading place. 3. The change is necessary as part of a wider public realm active travel improvement scheme, which includes upgrading the railway arches in Mepham Street, widening the footway on the north-east side of Mepham Street and the installation of a new speed table in Mepham Street at its junction with Waterloo Road which would assist in reducing vehicle speeds and provide safer road crossing
