

**LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH**  
**PROPOSED REMOVAL OF PARKING SPACES TO**  
**ACCOMMODATE A VEHICLE CROSSOVER IN**  
**NORTHBOURNE ROAD**

*(NOTE: This Notice is about proposals to remove a length of parking space and replace them with a single yellow line waiting restrictions so as to allow access to and from off-street parking facilities. Objections may be made – see paragraph 5.)*

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth on 1 December 2023 made the Lambeth (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No. 30) Order 2023 and the Lambeth (Charged for Parking Places) (Amendment No.27) Order 2023, under powers granted by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

2. The general effect of the Orders is to reduce the permit holder parking place on the south-west side of Northbourne Road outside No. 14 and replace it with a single yellow line waiting restriction that would apply during the times that the local Controlled Parking Zone operates

3. The proposed Orders are required to allow access to and from off-street parking facilities at the vehicle crossover at the location referred to in paragraph 2 above. If you have any enquiries, please telephone the Council's Transportation Group on 020 7926 9318.

If any person wishes to question the validity of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders are made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
