

TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

The Lewisham (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Consolidation) (Amendment No *) Order 202*

The Lewisham (Charged for Parking Places) (Consolidation) (Amendment No *) Order 202*

The Council of the London Borough of Lewisham proposes to make the above Traffic Regulation Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

1. **PTO 1032** - The effect of these proposals will be to introduce cycle hangars (secure cycle parking facilities for hire) at the locations described below and will be approximately 2.5m in length.

Aitken Road	on the north-east side, outside No.8 (replacing permit holders parking)
Algiers Street	on the south side, outside No.51/53
Ardgowan Road	on the east side, outside No.43
Bargery Road	on the north-east side, opposite No.2
Conington Road	on the north-east side, outside No.45/47 (replacing permit holders parking)
Davenport Road	on the north side, outside No.13 (replacing shared-use parking)
Dowanhill Road	on the south side, outside No.45/47
Elsinore Road	on the west side, outside St James Court
Elthruda Road	on the south-east side, outside No.38 (replacing permit holders parking)
Erlanger Road	on the west side, outside No.84/86
Highclere Road	on the south-west side, outside No. 29
Malpas Road	on the south-east side, outside No.48/50
Mercia Grove	on the north-east side, outside No 7 (replacing permit holders parking)
Old Road	on the south-east side, adjacent to No. 2 Aislibie Road (replacing permit holders parking)
Radford Road	on the north-west side, outside No.11 (replacing permit holders parking)
Ringstead Road	on the south side, outside No.102 (replacing permit holders)
Sportsbank Street	on the south side, outside No.34/36 (replacing permit holders)
Tyrwhitt Road	on the east side, outside No.19
Veda Road	on the south side, outside No.9/11
Westbourne Drive	on the east side, outside Pikethorne
