## The Lewisham (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Consolidation) (Amendment No \*) Order 202\*

The Lewisham (Charged for Parking Places) (Consolidation) (Amendment No \*) Order 202\* The Council of the London Borough of Lewisham proposes to make the above Traffic Regulation Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).
