ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3214 GLA ROAD (BUCKINGHAM PALACE ROAD, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2024

1. Transport for London in consultation with the City of Westminster and Network Rail hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to manhole frame and cover replacement works to take place on the A3214 Buckingham Palace Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle:
 - (1) from entering, exiting or proceeding in a south westerly direction on Buckingham Palace Road between its junctions with Terminus Place and Eccleston Bridge;
 - (2) from stopping at the south-eastern kerb-line on Buckingham Palace Road between its junctions with Victoria Street and Eccleston Bridge;
 - (3) except local buses and vehicles authorised to access Terminal Place from entering or proceeding in a south-westerly direction on Buckingham Palace Road between its junctions with Victoria Street and Terminus Place;
 - (4) except local buses from stopping in the City of Westminster controlled parking bays and Network Rail permit holders bays at the north-western kerblines on Bridge Place between its junctions with Hudson's Place and Belgrave Road.

The Order will be effective between 10:00 PM on the 14th January 2024 until 5:00 AM on the 15th of January 2024 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Grosvenor Gardens, Hobart Place, Eaton Square and Elizabeth Street to normal route of travel.
