

Transport for London Notice

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A202 GLA ROAD (NEATHOUSE PLACE, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2024

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable mobile crane works to take place on the A202 Neathouse Place.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) proceeding west bound from Neathouse Place into Bridge Place;
 - (2) stopping at the north-western kerb line on Neathouse Place;The Order will be effective at certain times between the 14th January 2024 and the 4th February every Sunday 07.00 AM until 07.00 PM or when the works have been completed whichever is sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs. Wilton Road (Southbound), Warwick Way, Gillingham Street, and Belgrave Road to normal route of travel.
