

## LICENSING ACT 2003

### Application for Grant of Premises Licence

Jaber Mohammed Julfiker has applied to the London Borough of Lambeth for the grant of a Premises Licence, in respect of the following premises: London Institute for Healthcare Engineering, 100 Lambeth Palace Road, London, SE1 7EH which would authorise the following licensable activities:

Live Music - 7:00-00:00 (Indoor only); Recorded Music - 7:00-00:00 (Indoor only); Provision of late night refreshment - 23:00-00:00 (Indoor only); Supply of Alcohol - 10:00-00:00 (on the premises only).

A responsible authority or any other person may make representation to the licensing authority in respect of this application. Representations must be made in writing, either by post to the above address, or by email to [licensing@lambeth.gov.uk](mailto:licensing@lambeth.gov.uk) and must be received no later than 01/02/2024.

It is an offence to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with a licensing application, and the maximum fine for which a person is liable on summary conviction for that offence shall not exceed level 5 on the standard scale (£5,000).
