## Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 The Lewisham (Casella Road, SE14) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made the above named

temporary traffic Order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of Thames Water works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the Order are indicated below.

1. (1) No right turn into, or out of, Casella Road, SE14 at its junction with New Cross Road. (2) The diversion routes for traffic affected by the prohibition are via, New Cross Road, Billington Road, Camplin Street and Casella Road, and vice versa.

Exemption is provided in the Order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.
 The Order comes into force on the 13th May 2024 to remain in force

The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
