

TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

The Lewisham (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Consolidation) (Amendment No *) Order 202* **The Lewisham (Charged for Parking Places) (Consolidation) (Amendment No *) Order 202***

PTO 1038

The Council of the London Borough of Lewisham proposes to make the above Traffic Regulation Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

- PTO 1038** - The effect of the proposals will be to introduce various no waiting 'at any time' restrictions and revoke existing restrictions to facilitate the introduction of new bus stop clearways for the 'Hail and Ride' conversion for Route 336 bus programme:- (a) Whitefoot Lane – on the south side of the carriageway, introduce 3m of no waiting 'at any time' on the western side of the bus stop clearway and 10m of no waiting 'at any time' on the eastern side of the bus stop clearway (replacing unrestricted parking places) outside 1 to 54 Forster House.
- (Note: On 19 January 2024 the Council published a Notice containing proposals to introduce various no waiting 'at any time' restrictions and revoke existing restrictions on certain roads. The previously advertised proposals on Whitefoot Lane will be replaced by the proposals in paragraph 1 and will not affect the proposals on Canadian Avenue, Fordmill Road, Brookhowse Road, Plough Way, Donderry Road, Churchdown, Torridon Road, Haddington Road, Oakshade Road and Shroffold Road/Ravenscar Road.)
