## LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 The Lewisham (Taymount Rise, Forestholme Close & Grassmount, SE23) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made the above named temporary Traffic Order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the Order are indicated below.

 (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in Taymount Rise, Forestholme Close and Grassmount, SE23. (2) There are no diversion routes for vehicular traffic affected by the prohibitions, but access is maintained as far as practicable for residents.

The one way working in Taymount Rise, around the roundabout, is suspended as required.

 Exemption is provided in the Order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform.

4. The Order comes into force on the 12th February 2024 to remain in force for up to 12 months.

5. The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
