ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A205 GLA ROADS (CHRISTCHURCH ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND BANNED TURNS) ORDER 2024

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above-named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable Thames Water repair works to take place on sections of A205 Christchurch Road.
3. The effects of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) entering, exiting or proceeding on the eastbound carriageway of Christchurch Road between its junction with Brixton Hill and Garden Lane, except for cycles;
 - (2) turning left into Christchurch Road from Streatham Hill, except for cycles;
 - (3) turning right into Christchurch Road from Brixton Hill, except for cycles.

The Order will be effective at certain times from 10:00 PM on 14th February 2024 until 5:00 AM on 15th February 2024 or when those works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs: for southbound traffic via Streatham High Road, Leigham Court Road, Crown Lane, Knight Hill and Norwood Road to normal route of travel. for northbound traffic via Brixton Hill, Brixton Road, Stockwell Road, Stockwell Park Walk, Brixton Road, Effra Road, Tulse Hill and Norwood Road to normal route of travel.
