ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3 GLA ROAD (CLAPHAM COMMON NORTH SIDE, LONDON BOROUGH OF WANDSWORTH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2024

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to allow water valve repair works to take place on the A3 Clapham Common North Side.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle:
 - (1) travelling in a northerly direction on Clapham Common North Side from entering Marjorie Grove at its junction with Clapham Common North Side;
 - (2) from stopping on the northern side of Clapham Common North Side between its junctions with Marjorie Grove and Elspeth Road;
 - (3) from stopping in the Parking and Disabled Persons' Vehicles Bay on Marjorie Grove, the west side, outside Nos. 1 to 8 Grove Mansions, Clapham Common North Side;
 - (4) from stopping in the Parking and Disabled Persons' Vehicles Bay on Marjorie Grove, the east side, opposite Nos. 1 to 8 Grove Mansions, Clapham Common North Side.

The Order will be effective from 6:00 AM on 27th January 2024 until 5:00 AM on 29th January 2024 or until the works has been completed. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via Sisters Avenue, Clapham Common North Side and Marjorie Grove and then to normal route of travel.
