ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A202 GLA ROAD (KENNINGTON LANE, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above-named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable railway bridge works to take place at Kennington Lane.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) entering, exiting or proceeding on A202 Kennington Lane between its junction with South Lambeth Road and Harleyford Street;
 - (2) entering South Lambeth Road at its junction with A202 Kennington Lane;
 - (3) stopping in the Solo Motorcycle Only bay on the A3202 Albert Embankment opposite No. 85 Albert Embankment;

This Order will also allow pedestrians to share the dedicated cycle path on the north side of Kennington Lane which runs under the bridge between Albert Embankment and South Lambeth Road.

Works will be phased such that some restrictions will apply only at certain times.

The Order will be effective every night from 9:00 PM until 5:00 AM between 15th January 2024 and 17th January 2024 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.

At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs for **eastbound traffic to the closure of Kennington Lane** via South Lambeth Road, Clapham Road, Stockwell Road, Brixton Road, Kennington Park Road to normal route of travel. For **southbound traffic to the closure of South Lambeth Road** via Kennington Lane, Durham Street, Harleyford Street north-westbound to normal route of traffic.
