ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE A2 GLA ROAD (NEW CROSS ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to allow telecom works to take place on the A2 New Cross Road.3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering or

proceeding in an easterly direction on New Cross Road from its

- junctions with Pomeroy Street to the extended common boundary of Nos. 21 and 23 New Cross Road.

 The Order will be effective between 9:00 PM on 12th February 2024 and 5:00 AM on 13th February 2024 or until the works has been completed. whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibition will not apply in respect of:
 - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police
 - constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs. Pomeroy Street, Queens Road, Old Kent Road, Rotherrithe Old Road, Lower Road, Evelyn Street to normal route of travel.
