## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE A3 GLA ROAD (PRIMA ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2024

- I. Transport for London in consultation with the London Borough of Lambeth hereby gives notice that it has made the above-named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable gas mains maintenance and refurbishment works to take place at Prima Road.
- refurbishment works to take place at Prima Road.

  3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering,

with A3 Clapham Road and Pickle Mews.

Works will be phased such that some restrictions will apply only at certain times.

exiting, stopping or proceeding on Prima Road between its junctions

The Order will be effective from 7:00 AM on 15th January 2024 until 7:00 PM on 3rd March 2024 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
     anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police
  - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.

At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Brixton Road, Handforth Road, Clapham Road and vice versa to normal route of traffic.
