

# Transport for London Notice

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

### THE A205 GLA ROAD (THURLOW PARK ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above-named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable a mobile crane operation works to take place at the A205 Thurlow Park Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
  - (1) entering, exiting, or proceeding in an easterly direction on the A205 Thurlow Park Road between its junctions with Norwood Road and the easterly building line of No 5. Thurlow Park Road.
  - (2) stopping in the parking and disabled person's vehicles bay outside No. 5 Thurlow Park Road;
  - (3) stopping at the northern kerb-line of Tulse Hill between its junctions with Hardel Rise and Norwood Road;

No pedestrian may use the northbound footway of Thurlow Park Road between its junction with Norwood Road and the extended common boundary of Nos. 5 and 7 Thurlow Park Road, residential access will be maintained.

The Order will be effective between the dates of 21st January 2024 and 29th January 2024, every Sunday at 10:00 PM until Monday at 5:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
  - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs for eastbound traffic via Norwood Road, Croxted Road and to normal route of travel. Southbound traffic on Norwood Road southbound, Christchurch Road, Hardel Rise and Tulse Hill eastbound to the diversion route above. Pedestrian Diversion via southern footway of Thurlow Park Road to the zebra crossing at its junction with Birbeck Road and the northern footway of Thurlow Park Road or the reverse to normal route of travel.
