ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS-
SUSPENSION OF ONE-WAY SYSTEM – PAXTON
PLACE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Thames Water repair and maintenance works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily:

- (a) ban vehicles from entering in that length of Paxton Place which lies between the property boundary of No. 251 Gipsy Road and the north-western property boundary of No. 4 Paxton Place;
- (b) suspend the Order imposing a one-way system in Paxton Place towards Hamilton Road.

2. An alternative route for affected vehicles will be available via Gipsy Road and Hamilton Road and vice versa.

3. The ban and suspension of the one-way system will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing and/or covering of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 26th February 2024 for a maximum duration of 3 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works will be completed within 4 days, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during this time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 3 months.
