ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – RADBOURNE ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Thames Water repair and maintenance works to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Radbourne Road, which lies between Nos.100 and 103a Radbourne Road.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via (a) Emmanuel Road, Thornton Road and Hydethorpe Road; and (b) Burnbury Road, Telferscot Road and Emmanuel Road. Access to properties will be maintained.

3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing and covering of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order comes into force on 14 February 2024 and would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the said works have been completed, whichever is sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the Order will only have effect on 14 February 2024 between the hours of 9:30am and 3:30pm, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the order would also have effect on subsequent dates within that maximum duration of 1 month.
