

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS - SOUTH
LAMBETH ROAD AND LANSDOWNE WAY

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable Thames Water to carry out water valve cover repair and replacement works, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban heavy goods vehicles weighting 7.5 tonnes or more proceeding in South Lambeth Road (a northerly or southerly direction) from entering Lansdowne Way.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via (a) South Lambeth Road, Parry Street and Wandsworth Road; and (b) South Lambeth Road, Clapham Road, Clapham High Street, Clapham Common South Side, Long Road, Cedars Road and Wandsworth Road.

3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 23 February 2024 and continue in force for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works will take place on 23 and 24 February 2024, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent dates within the maximum period of 2 months.
