Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The Lewisham (Canonbie Road, SE23)

(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made the above named temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of Thames Water works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

- 1.** (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in Canonbie Road, SE23 between the projected southwestern kerbline of Forest Hill Road and a point 15 metres southwestwards thereof. (2) The diversion routes for traffic affected by the prohibition are via (i) Forest Hill Road, Wood Lane, Langton Rise, Westwood Park, and Canonbie Road, and vice versa; and (ii) Forest Hill Road, Netherby Road, and Canonbie Road, and vice versa.
- 2.** Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.
- 3.** The order comes into force on the 7th March 2024 to remain in force for up to 2 months. (Note: Works are planned to take place between 7th and 12th March but additional duration is given for contingencies).
- 4.** The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
