NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made the above named temporary traffic Order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of regeneration works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the Order are indicated below.

 (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in (i) Creekside, between Deptford Church Street and 79/81 Creekside; (ii) Bronze Street;
(iii) Berthon Street; and (iv) Copperas Street. (2) The alternative routes for traffic affected by the prohibitions are via Creekside, Deptford Church Street, Creek Road, and Creekside as applicable during the works.
(Note: Works are planned to continue until September 2024. Access to off-street parking areas, Bronze Street, Berthon Street and Copperas Street, will generally be maintained during the works).

 Exemption is provided in the Order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform.

3. The Order comes into force on the 5th February 2024 to remain in force for up to 9 months.

4. The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
