ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A232 GLA ROAD (ADDISCOMBE ROAD, HAVELOCK ROAD AND WOODBURY CLOSE, LONDON BOROUGH OF CROYDON) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2024

1. Transport for London in consultation with the London Borough of Croydon hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable drainage inspection works to take place on the A232 Addiscombe Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) stopping on Addiscombe Road between a point 13 metres east of the extended eastern building line of No. 209 Addiscombe Road and its junction with Havelock Road;
 - (2) stopping on Havelock Road between its junction with Addiscombe Road and a point 12 metres north of the extended common property boundary of No. 203 Addiscombe Road and No. 4 Havelock Road;
 - (3) stopping on the eastern side of Outram Road between its junction with Addiscombe Road and a point 16.5 metres south of the extended northern building line of Napier Court, Outram Road;
 - (4) entering, exiting or proceeding on Woodbury Close between a point 18 metres south of the extended northern property boundary line of No. 84 Addiscombe Road and its junction with Addiscombe Road.

Local access will be maintained to Woodbury Close and Homefield Place.

The Order will be effective at certain times between 4th March 2024 and 6th March 2024 each night 9:00 PM to 5:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
