- I. Transport for London in consultation with the Royal Borough of Greenwich hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable manhole covers and frame repair works to take place on the A2213 Greenwich High Road.3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from: entering,
- exiting or proceeding in a northerly direction on Greenwich High Road between its junction with Deptford Bridge/ Blackheath Road and a point 4 meters south-west of the extent of the extended common boundary of Nos. 15 and 17 Greenwich High Road.

 The Order will be effective between 10:00 PM on 19th February 2024 and 5:00 AM on 20th February 2024, or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be
- indicated by traffic signs.

 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs. West bound traffic, Blackheath Road, Greenwich South Street, Greenwich High Road, Deptford Bridge. East bound traffic, Creek Road, Greenwich Church Street, College Approach, King William Walk, Nelson Road and Greenwich High Road to normal route of travel.
