ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3220 GLA ROAD (HOLLAND ROAD, ROYAL BOROUGH OF KENSINGTON AND CHELSEA) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2024

1. Transport for London in consultation with the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable mobile telecommunications equipment upgrading works to take place on the A3220 Holland Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping on Holland Road between its junctions with Napier Place and Kensington High Street;
 - (2) stopping on Warwick Road, between the extended common boundary of a and b St Mary Abbot's Garages, Warwick Road and a point 16 metres southeast of the extended common boundary of Nos. 3 and 4 St Mary Abbot's Garages, Warwick Road.

Bus diversions will be in place during the closures.

The Order will be effective between 7:00 AM and 7:00 PM on Sunday 4th February 2024 and between 7:00 AM and 7:00 PM on Sunday 7th April 2024 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via: Hammersmith Road, left down Butterwick, along Hammersmith flyover, up Queen Caroline Street, up Shepherds Bush Road, up Shepherds Bush Green, right down Uxbridge Road and down Holland Road. Along Kensington High Street, left up Kensington Church Street, left along Holland Park Avenue and left down Holland Road and then to normal route of travel.
