ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A23 GLA ROAD (OAKLANDS AVENUE, LONDON BOROUGH OF CROYDON) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2024

- 1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the abovenamed Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable BT duct laying and clearing blockage works to take place at A23 London Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from stopping in the Parking and Disabled Persons Vehicles Bay at the side of Nos. 998 London Road in Oaklands Avenue.

The Order will be effective from 19th February 2024 and 23rd February 2024 every night 10:00 PM to 5:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of: (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire
 - brigade, ambulance or police purposes; (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police
 - constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
