 3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the
- appropriate traffic signs.

 4. The Order would come into force on 27 March 2024 and would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is

completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would take place for one day on 27 March 2024, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 1 month.
