Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The Lewisham (Blythe Hill Lane, SE6)

(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council intend to make the above named temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of Thames Water works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order will be as indicated below.

- 1.** (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in Blythe Hill Lane, SE6, between Blythe Hill and Winterbourne Road. (2) The diversion routes for traffic affected by the prohibition shall be via Blythe Hill Lane, Stanstead Road, Ravensbourne Road, and Blythe Hill, and vice versa.
- 2.** Exemption will be provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.
- 3.** The Order is intended to come into force on the 13th May 2024 to remain in force for up to 2 months. (Note: Works are proposed to be carried out between 13th and 17th May 2024).
- 4.** The prohibitions will apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
