## Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 The Lewisham (Crystal Palace Park Road, SE26) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made the above named temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM

- 1. (1) All vehicular traffic shall be prohibited from entering Crystal Palace Park Road, SE26 from Westwood Hill. (2) The alternative routes for traffic affected by the prohibition are via (i) Westwood Hill, Lawrie Park Road, and Crystal Palace Park Road; and (ii) Westwood Hill, Crystal Palace Parade, Anerley Hill, Anerley Road, Croydon Road, High Street and Crystal Palace
- Park Road Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.
- 3. The order comes into force on the 1st May 2024 to remain in force for up to 3 months. (Note: Works are planned for 27th to 31st May 2024 but additional duration has been given in case of postponement etc). 4. The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the
